| Preparation | Level 3 – Award 4-5 Marks Complete and exemplary evidence of written preparation. |

| Timing and Content | Level 3 – Award 4-5 Marks Speaks for the full allocated time, without pause or interruption. Speaks exclusively on the subject selected, is precise, concise and purposeful. Speaks without the use of any written or visual aids. |
| Mark: | Level 2 – Award 2-4 Marks Speaks for more than half of the allocated time, with limited pause or interruption. Speaks exclusively on the subject selected, but lacks precision and focus at times. |
| | Level 1 – Award 0-2 Marks Speaks for less than half of the allocated time and or fails to focus on the subject and lacks purpose. |
| Manner and Presentation | Level 3 – Award 4-5 Marks Projects and modulates consistently, uses rhetorical skill, body language and positioning throughout and with exemplary effect. |
| Mark: | Level 2 – Award 2-4 Marks Projects well but modulates and uses body language inconsistently, increasing evidence of rhetorical skill. |
| | Level 1 – Award 0-2 Marks Fails to project or modulate voice, use of body language is limited, rhetorical skill is largely unevicenced. |
| Response to questioning | Level 3 – Award 4-5 Marks Responds convincingly and thoughtfully to both questions, in line with the Level 3 criteria for Timing and Content and Manner and Presentation. |

Viva Exam

In preparation for your Viva exam on _____ you will need to create a model of a volcano OR create a poster about a volcano of your choice.

1) Make a model of a volcano

Your volcano model must:

- Have labels or a diagram on one side
- Look attractive and can be made from any materials
- Have different features such as vent, crater, magma chamber, ash cloud, lava etc
- This model can explode if you want but be aware that it'll go in the bin afterwards



2) Create a poster about a volcano of your choice

Your volcano poster must:

- Include an example of a real-life volcano and how it is formed (its location and plate boundary)
- Information about the volcano's eruption (when it happened, who it effects, how people responded to the eruption)
- Be eye-catching and presented on paper (NOT emailed to your teacher). It must look like a poster; this can be 3D but must look like it has taken more than 2 hours to produce NOT 2 minutes!



Viva Exam: On the day of your Viva exam you will be expected to present your model/poster to the rest of your class in 2 minutes, so make sure you come prepared! You will be assessed on preparation, timing and content, manner and presentation and your response to a question from your peers/teacher.
