Dear Parents and Carers,

Homework, or Home Learning, as we are now calling it, is due to start this week. Work will be set every Friday.

The work will all be on Class Dojo. There will be:

1 piece of English This could be comprehension, grammar or punctuation, or a longer written

piece.

1 piece of Maths This will link to the national curriculum and our Inspire Maths scheme of

work

1 piece of Science or Topic - There will be a minimum of one science or topic piece over the duration

of the topic.

1 lot of Spellings – EYFS – These will be focused on the phonics sounds that they are learning in

class.

KS1 – They will have 5 words to learn (this will increase over the academic

year)

KS2 – They will have a minimum of 10 words to learn

Spellings handed out on Friday will be tested the following Friday.

Reading – All children must read with an adult at least 5 times a week. We will be sending books home, but you can read anything you have at home. Every child also has access to Bug Club books online. If you require access, please contact your class teacher on Class Dojo and they will send you your log in details.

We have ordered reading record books for your children which we hope will arrive shortly. These are designed for you to log your child's reading and will be signed and checked by your class teacher on a weekly basis to ensure that they are reading at least 5 times a week.

The Home Learning that is being set is either in preparation for upcoming learning that they will be doing in class or as a consolidation of work already taught.
