All of the children now know what to do if they are the victim of bullying. They all know that they should 'Speak up, Stand Tall' and that a 'Small change can make a big difference.'

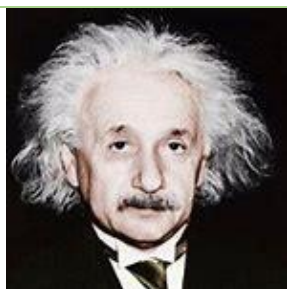

NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM EDUCATIONAL VISIT

Year 4 and 5 visited the Natural History Museum on Thursday 5th December. They analysed and investigated a wide range of scientific objects in a workshop, including fool's gold, antlers, spiders and many more wonderful items.

The children saw a moving and roaring T-rex and many more dinosaur fossils in one gallery. They also had great fun exploring the hands on activities in the earthquake and volcanic zone. They even experienced an earthquake in a Kobe supermarket.
