All educational visits, school clubs and breakfast club must be paid by ParentPay. If your child is going from year 2, to year 3 and you're not eligible for Free School Meals, you must top-up by ParentPay.

Payment must be provided for the whole term which will be from 09.09.2019 – 18.10.2019. Breakfast club will be at a set cost of £2.00. Breakfast club must be booked and paid for in advance. We insist that there must be sufficient funds on your child's ParentPay account in the first instance. Unfortunately, if there are insufficient funds your child cannot attend.
