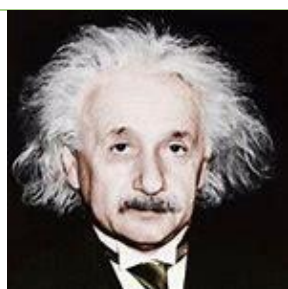
Dates for your diary
