# We are now cashless!

All educational visits, school clubs and breakfast club must be paid by ParentPay. If your child is going from year 2, to year 3 and you're not eligible for Free School Meals, you must top-up by ParentPay.

Payment must be provided for the whole term which will be from 09.09.2019 – 18.10.2019. Breakfast club will be at a set cost of £2.00. Breakfast club must be booked and paid for in advance. We insist that there must be efficient funds on your child's ParentPay account in the first instance. If there are no sufficient funds your child cannot attend. Thank you

Your child MUST wear a PE kit for PE lessons. Years 1, 2 and 3 have PE on Tuesdays and Year's 4, 5 and 6 have it on Thursdays.

Our PE kit is a plain white T-shirt and black shorts. Trainers or plimsolls must also be worn.
