

#### How Eastbrook School received £9,838 per pupil

**Compared to schools like you:** Eastbrook School receives 0.1% more from grant funding and 0.1% less from self generated funding. In particular, Eastbrook School receives noticeably more in direct grants and income from catering, and noticeably less in targeted grants and community grants.

**Compared to the national average for all-through schools:** Eastbrook School receives 3.8% more from grant funding and 1.3% less from self generated funding. In particular, Eastbrook School receives noticeably more in direct grants and income from catering, and noticeably less in community grants and targeted grants.








# How Eastbrook School spent £9,670 per pupil

**Compared to schools like you:** Eastbrook School spends 9.7% less on staff, 10.6% more on occupation, 1.2% less on supplies and services, 0.6% more on premises and 0.2% less on finance. In particular, Eastbrook School spends noticeably more on occupation total and premises total, and noticeably less on staff total and supplies and services total.

**Compared to the national average for all-through schools:** Eastbrook School spends 7.5% less on staff, 9.8% more on occupation, 0.1% more on supplies and services, 0.1% less on premises and 0.3% less on finance. In particular, Eastbrook School spends noticeably more on occupation total and supplies and services total, and noticeably less on staff total and cost of finance total.






