

Dear Parent/Carer,

We have been very proud of Year 11 whilst they have been sitting their final GCSE exams this season, the resilience and determination they have shown in revising towards their exams has been impressive. We know students have found it useful when we have dropped the usual timetable lessons on particular days to give students additional intense revision towards upcoming exams, for example we dropped the Year 11 Maths lesson the day before the big English paper on 24th May last term, which made the children feel really well equipped to face their final Literature paper.
